(*BUT WERE AFRAID TO ASK)

DR. SAM ZWETCHKENBAUM

Complete denture treatment, like exercise, can be fun and satisfying when performed regularly. When we have fewer opportunities, we forget the fundamentals and it can be frustrating or even painful. This talk will review some important basics, from impression making through delivery and speedy evaluation of post-insertion complaints. The importance of determination of vertical dimension of occlusion, proper border extension, use of the facebow, and the role of clinical remount and occlusal equilibration will also be discussed.



Dr. Sam Zwetchkenbaum is Section Chief of Hospital Dentistry at the University of Michigan School of Dentistry and Health System. He received his D.D.S. at the University of North Carolina in 1987 and completed a General Practice Residency at Hennepin County Medical Center in Minneapolis. He received advanced training in Prosthodontics at UMDNJ New Jersey Dental School and then Maxillofacial Prosthodontics at M.D. Anderson Cancer Center in Houston, Texas. He received a M.P.H. in Health Management and Policy from the U of M School of Public Health in 2006. Current clinical care involves maxillofacial prosthodontics and hospital dentistry; Sam is the program director of U of M's General Practice Residency.

Millions of people worldwide suffer diminished quality of life due to the effects of pain Temporomandibular Disorders. Temporomandibular Disorders are associated with increased risk of facial pain, headaches. Clicking, even without pain, can lead to numerous Jaw problems. Oral Orthotic Appliances (OA) that treat TMD symptoms, headaches and facial pain are devices worn in the mouth at night and possible during the day time. They are made of plastic and fit partially or completely within the mouth. There are different types of oral appliances available. OA's may be used alone or in combination with other means of treating TMD, facial pain and headaches, such as physical therapy, pharmacotherapy and surgery. There is no one particular appliance that will work for every patient.
