“CURRENT CYBERCRIME TRENDS IMPACTING THE FINANCIAL INFRASTRUCTURE “

Speaker: Special Agent Christopher Sliger

Our topic is a critical long-term issue for all of us. How safe is your data? Is the cloud as safe as they say? Should you be backing up your data yourself as well as the cloud? How safe are you and your patient information? Do all your computers access the internet?

This will be an overview of current and emerging threats to the cyber landscape and monetization of stolen and ransomed data. Topics include:

- Identity Theft
- Access Device Fraud
- Ransom ware
- Business Email Compromise
- Discussion on securing important digital data

Special Agent Christopher Sliger has been with the US Secret Service since 2011 and has been the Team Lead for the Detroit Field Office's Network Intrusion Responder program (NITRO) for the majority of that time. He has leveraged a degree in Information Systems from Middle Tennessee State University, a background with networked systems in the private sector, and a newfound knowledge of virtual currencies into numerous international investigations concerning theft and resale of financial access devices and personally identifiable information by cybercriminal organizations.
