"Advanced Diagnostics, Image interpretation, and Clinical use of Cone Beam Scans in Dentistry"

Dr. Ghabi A. Kaspo's practice is dedicated exclusively to the conservative treatment of TMJ disorders, chronic orofacial pain management, and sleep disorders.

He obtained a D.D.S. and a Diploma in Orthodontics from Damascus University and a D.D.S. from the University of Detroit Mercy. He received a Certificate of Training in TMJ and Orofacial Pain Management after completing a one-year, full time fellowship program at the University of Medicine and Dentistry of New Jersey. He is a Diplomat of both the American Board of Orofacial Pain and the American Board of Dental Sleep Medicine.

Dr. Kaspo has lectured locally, nationally and internationally. He has published articles relating to TMJ disorders in local, national and international dental journals. He also contributed a chapter to Fibromyalgia: The Complete Guide From Medical Experts and Patients.

Dr. Kaspo owns a 3D Cone Beam CT on which he has performed more than 1700 scans for TMJ disorders and facial pain patients, and implants, orthodontics, and oral surgery patients.

Objectives:

Familiarize participants with the appearance of the anatomical structures of the maxillofacial region and the head and neck in general, as well as their variants, as seen on computed tomography.

Discuss how 3D imaging can prevent complications and reduce risks in surgical procedures.

Present the pertinent CT imaging findings of jaw pathology and their interpretation.

Discuss how the CT data collection combined with available clinical information and history will contribute to the formation of a "differential diagnosis."
