***About Dr. Machado:***

Dr. Camilo Machado obtained his dental degree in 1984 from The National University of Colombia. After attended three years of graduate education at the Intercontinental University in Mexico, he was awarded a certificate in the specialty of Prosthodontics in 1996. Upon migration to the United States he received his master degree in Clinical Dentistry and Biomaterials at the University of Alabama at Birmingham in 2003. He was an Assistant Professor at The National University of Colombia and University of El Bosque in Bogota, Colombia for over 15 years. He was faculty at the Department of Comprehensive Care, and Department of Prosthodontics and Biomaterials at the University of Alabama at Birmingham. He was an Assistant Professor at Ohio State University, College of Dentistry for 5 years, and an Associate Professor at the University of Detroit Mercy School of Dentistry. Currently, Dr. Machado owns a family practice in St. Clair Shores, Michigan. He holds a special interest in the development of new technologies in the areas of Prosthodontics, Biomaterials, and CAD-CAM. He is an active member of the International Association for Dental Research, the American Association for Dental Research, The American Dental Education Association, International Prosthodontics Society, Institute of Nanotechnology and Carl Boucher Prosthodontics Society.

## **BOARD REPORTS**

### **THE DETROIT DENTAL CLINIC CLUB SWITCHES TO E-MAIL NOTIFICATION.**

Our Club is joining the rest of the world by switching to e-mail as the primary method of communication. This doesn't mean though, that those of you without e-mail address will be left out. It simply means that our first choice in communicating with our members will be e-mail. If you don't have an e-mail account, you will continue to receive your communications using the U S Post Office "snail mail". We can do this because we will be using "Constant Contact", an e-mail service that can tell us which e-mail addresses are valid and receive e-mail and which e-mail addresses are invalid and not receiving e-mail. In the case of an invalid e-mail address or a member without an e-mail address, we will continue to use the Post Office as we have done before. This will not only speed up our communications but also allow us to communicate much more economically and frequently since our mailing efforts and costs will be greatly reduced. Expect more relevant and frequent communications if you have an e-mail address. Finally we encourage all members to provide us with their e-mail address so that we can fully implement this system and save costs. Those who receive this current newsletter by "snail mail" will notice an additional page asking for their current e-mail address if they have one, so they can be included in our roster of valid e-mail addresses. If we don't get your e-mail address, we still love you but we would love you even more if you would get an e-mail address.

### **CONTINUING EDUCATION CREDITS**

All formally structured educational programs put on by the DDCC are eligible for AGD credit. The DDCC Board is required to submit a roster of those in attendance including the identification number of an AGD member within thirty days of the meeting. You must sign in with your name and number at each meeting to receive credit.

### **DUES AND MEETING REGISTRATION HAVE CHANGED**

At our board meeting last May the financial committee reported that for the past several years our Club has been losing money. Increasing meeting costs, especially meal costs have been depleting our treasury, often as much as \$2,000 a year. The board resolved to correct this imbalance and return our Club to "break even status". Toward that end, at our May meeting dues were increased by \$10 to \$75 a year. (They had been \$65 for a very long time.) But this is still not enough to solve all our financial problems.

Our increased expenses have come primarily from the escalating cost of meals. So it was decided that the members who actually eat the meals should pick up the extra cost. Toward this end a surcharge of \$30 per meal has been enacted for those attending a meeting. Members still realize substantial savings since the individual meal cost of \$75 is much higher for guests and non-paying life members.

The bottom line is -now you will send a check of \$30 to reserve your place instead of \$65. But instead of getting it refunded, we will keep it. These actions will ensure that our Club will remain financially solvent for the foreseeable future.
